Round-Trip Day Tour to Moraine Lake, Lake Louise, Emerald Lake and Takakkaw Falls

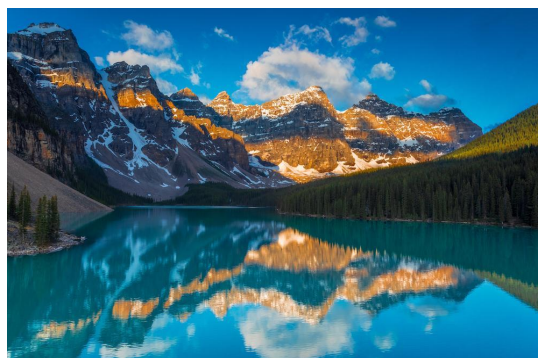


Important Information

11:00am	Leave Moraine Lake
11:15am	Visit Lake Louise
12:15pm	Leave Lake Louise
12:25pm	Lunch stop in Louise Village
1:00pm	Leave Louise Village
1:30pm	Visit Emerald Lake
2:30pm	Leave Emerald Lake
3:15pm	Visit Takakkaw Falls
4:00pm	Depart Takakkaw Falls
4:45pm	Lake Louise Drop off
5:25pm	Banff Drop off
5:45pm	Canmore Drop off

Frequently Asked Questions

What's included in my trip?

- A Professional Guide/Driver
- Private group transportation throughout
- Cold drinks and a light snack
- Water and reusable cups
- Stops outlined in the itinerary
- NW Calgary pickup & dropoff or Canmore, Banff & Lake Louise Hotel pickup & dropoff

What's not included in my trip?

- Stops not included in the itinerary
- Lunch
- Gratuity for Big Nature Guide/Driver
- Taxes and online booking fee
- Bottled Water

Are there other fees associated with my booking?

Yes, there is a Moraine Lake access fee implemented by Parks Canada (\$20 per guest), a 3% booking fee and 5% GST (mandatory government tax).

What should I expect?

- Temperatures ranging from 0° to 30° C (32° F to 86° F)
- Rain and possible snow, sun exposure
- Uneven terrain
- Possible delays in pickup / dropoff time due to traffic and road conditions
- Seating in van is first-come first-served

What should I bring?

- Hiking or good walking shoes
- A warm layer, rain jacket and pants
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray
- A refillable water bottle
- Lunch (or money to purchase lunch in Lake Louise)
- Gratuity for the Big Nature Guide/Driver (10-15% is customary)

What can't I bring?

- Pets (except accredited service animals)
- Glass bottles

Can I bring my children?

- Yes! Children under 5 are free, however you must provide a child seat that can be installed in the van.

Is there a minimum # of participants required to run the trip?

- Yes - if a tour date has less than 3 people registered we reserve the right to cancel.

Cancellation Policy

Up to 48 hours before your trip - should you wish to cancel, we will refund your full payment minus Big Nature's service fees, incurred by processing your transaction online through our payment processor. Cancellations within 48 hours of the trip are not eligible for refund.
